

Family-Initiated Rapid Response Extension 4444

CMC has a Rapid Response Team (RRT) available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The purpose of an RRT is to bring critical care expertise to patient bedsides. A healthcare provider may call the RRT anytime there is a sudden worsening in a patient's condition. An Intensive Care Unit (ICU) nurse and other healthcare providers will respond to assist the patient's nurse in obtaining additional treatment for your loved one.

FAMILY-INITIATED RAPID RESPONSE

A family member or visitor may alert the Rapid Response Team in the event of an emergency:

- > A serious change in the patient's condition.
- > Family members or visitors feel that a patient's condition is not being recognized.

This is an emergency call and should be made only for a serious change in your loved one's condition.

- > Dial extension 4444 from any hospital phone.
- > Give the Rapid Response Team member:
 - > Your name
 - > Patient's name
 - > Location (patient's room number)
 - > Brief description of what is wrong

The RRT will arrive within minutes to help you.
