- Osteoporosis (thus far the country's only facility to achieve this distinction)

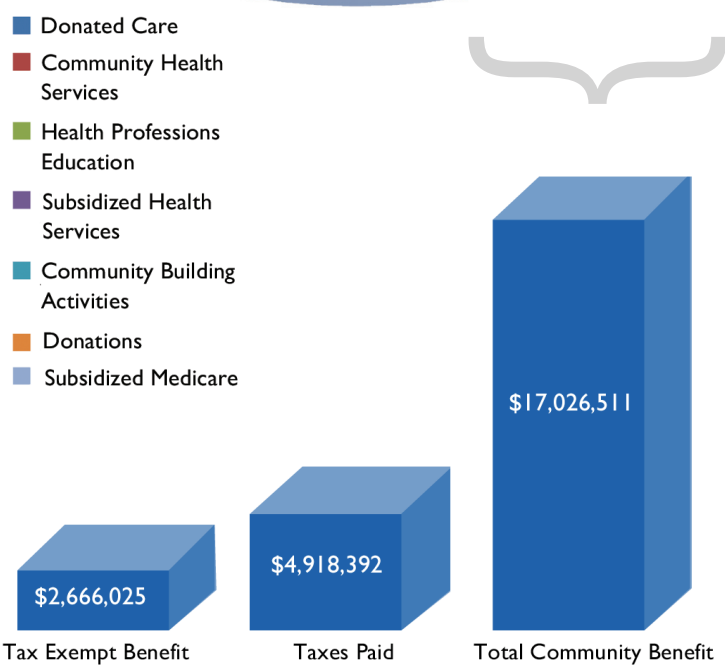
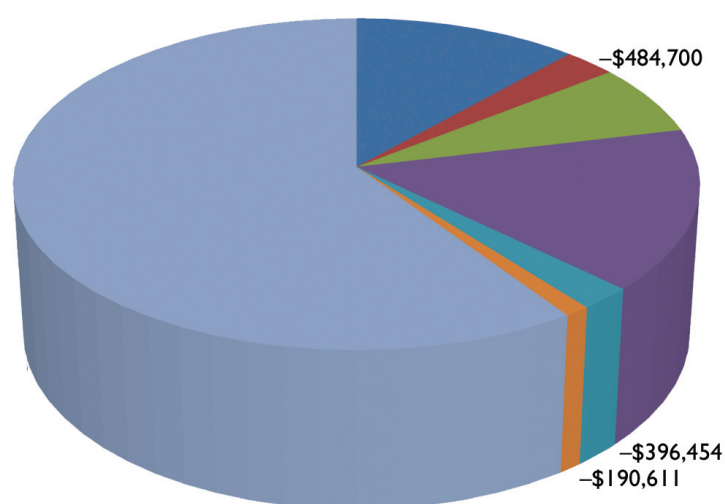
We're also listed as one of *US Reports'* Best Hospitals in recognition of our *2010 Silver Plus Achievement Award* and we're the first and only recipient of the American Orthopaedic Association's *Own the Bone* certification for a clinically-proven quality improvement program for osteoporosis.

OUR EXCELLENCE SHOWS IN OUR RESULTS*

- Overall length of stay is 13% below the median average, re-admission rate is 44% below.
- Orthopedic length-of-stay for total hip is 29% below the median average and our total knee surgery stay is 7% below the average.
- The percent of patients with total knee surgeries that are discharged to home is 35% above the national average, and the percent of our patients with total hip surgeries that are discharged to home is 28% above the national average
- Hospital-acquired and surgery infections rates are well below national averages
