Gift Planning Tips

IRA Opportunities

One 2010 donor wrote *"When doing my estate planning and rewriting my Will a few years ago, I was told that my IRA could be taxed up to 75% at the time of my death. This high percentage of taxation appalled me. As a result, I have been taking yearly distributions and I am also fulfilling my three-year commitment to the Women's and Newborn Center with a direct rollover from my IRA account to the CMC Foundation."*

If you own an IRA and are over age 70 ½, you may contact your IRA custodian to transfer up to \$100,000 in 2011 directly from your IRA to qualified nonprofit organizations like CMC Foundation. Credit still available for endowment giving

The Montana Charitable Endowment Tax Credit successfully survived the 2011 legislative session. This gives CMC donors until 2013 to take a Montana income tax credit of up to \$10,000 for certain gifts to CMC Foundation's permanent endowments. Funding a deferred gift annuity, for example, could end up costing only 25 to 50 cents on each dollar you give. Some businesses can also qualify for the credit.

What do CMC Foundation endowments make possible? Last year, endowment distributions provided sunscreen education programs in the elementary schools, funded high school and CMC employee healthcare education scholarships, brought needed equipment to obstetrics, and supported the work of the Foundation.
